Dear Primary Care colleagues

NHS West Yorkshire ICB would like to advise GP practices across West Yorkshire that we have direct contracts for Autism and ADHD assessments with providers in the below table. You are able to refer patients who are eligible for an Autism and/or ADHD assessment to any of these providers (and others who hold contracts outside of West Yorkshire) under the Right to Choose (RTC) legislation.

Providers who have contracts in one of our 5 places in West Yorkshire have a regular review of their service offer and places can provide assurance on the quality of their provision. Should the quality, safety or performance of any provider in England give cause for concern, the ICB or relevant authorities, such as the CQC, will notify partners, including primary care.

NHS funded monitoring of amber (shared-care) drugs is commissioned by each ICB place through a local enhanced-service with GP practices and the practice decides whether they can offer patients this service.

We are exploring ways to make it easier for GP practices to feel more able to enter shared-care agreements for ADHD medication, so people have a more consistent experience across West Yorkshire. We would expect however, that any organisation offering NHS-funded ADHD assessments which includes a medication pathway would have an existing mechanism in place to provide on-going prescriptions. Currently the providers that have direct contracts in West Yorkshire and are providing a medication pathway for ADHD are highlighted in colour.
