Good Medical Practice - shape the GMC guidance

The review is focusing on four main areas:

- 1. Tackling discrimination and promoting fairness and inclusion
- 2. Working in partnership with patients and the responsibility for professionals to help patients make decisions for themselves
- 3. Working effectively with colleagues
- 4. Leadership and organisational culture

The event will also focus on balancing competing rights and interests - and discuss new wording in the proposed guidance for access to treatment and care. We will ask for thoughts on the impact of the new proposed duty and discuss barriers and enablers to support further development of information that can be provided alongside the next version of good medical practice.
