About the project

NHSE/I has commissioned GPMplus to deliver this project to gain a better understanding of how general practice teams can be supported and developed, in order to develop a tailored support package to further support general practice workforce. To do this we will need to look at current support offers – who they are available to, uptake, usefulness, duplications, barriers to accessing, and most importantly identify the gaps in support. This will be done via a series of focus groups.

Although this is a West Yorkshire wide project, we understand there are different needs in different areas and therefore the focus groups will be place based. Likewise there will be different needs within practice teams so we will have practice team focus groups (inviting managers, administrative staff, receptionists, Nurses, other clinicians) and GP focus groups (inviting partners, salaried, locum and trainee GPs). We are keen to ensure we have a wide range of attendees to ensure good representation.

What's involved

The commitment will be 6 hours per attendee – this is for attendance at 3 focus groups between September and March. Reimbursement is available at the following rates:

- Practice Managers and other clinicians £45ph
- > Administrative and support staff £25ph
