3.	<b>Medical Secretary's report</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>NH referred members to Dr Sathiyaseelan's very comprehensive written report. No comments or questions raised.</li> <li>RS acknowledged the difficulties faced by the NHS and GP nationally. Colleagues and fellow LMCs recognise good relations in place with the CCG, health authorities and provider units. RS also mentioned the positive responses already received in support of the LMC GP Mentorship scheme recently launched. The LMC are hoping this will provide a good support platform for struggling GPs.</li> </ul>	Info
4.	<b>Treasurer's report</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>AB referred to her written report. In March 2018 the LMC increased both the voluntary and statutory levies by 2p per patient with effect from 1 April 2018. Meaning that the levies increased to £0.27 pence per patient for the statutory levy and £0.08 pence per patient for the voluntary levy. This was partly necessary to assist with long overdue office refurbishment. Leeds levies remain low compared nationally and with some neighbouring LMCs.</li> <li>No comments or questions raised.</li> </ul>	Info
